

- The sound is fuller in the maximum position and thinner in the minimum position.
4. Harmonic Coloration Switch - This two position switch selects between two distinct sounds. One is a full rich sound, the other a hollow synthetic sound.
 5. Treadle - The treadle or foot pedal controls the rate of flanging or chorus. The flanging or chorus is slowest with the toe up, approximately 1 cycle every 15 seconds. The fastest rate with the toe down is approximately 15 times per second. The rate can be varied while playing or will remain at any desired rate when your foot is removed.

IN CONCLUSION

The Morley Chorus Flanger can be used with many other effects such as (but not limited to) the Morley Electrostatic Delay Line or Power Wah Fuzz. Do not hesitate to experiment. Its full potential is dependent upon your own creativity and talent.


WARRANTY
