

Turn the "Sensitivity" knob completely clockwise, the "Decay" time completely clockwise and the "Boost" to "12 O'clock."

A signal from a guitar or other instrument will turn the gate on and when the signal diminishes to some low level, it will disappear as the gate turns off.

Rotating the "Sensitivity" knob more counter clockwise will reduce sensitivity, requiring a stronger signal to turn the gate on and also causing the gate to shut down at a higher level as the signal dies out. If there is only a little noise in the electrical environment, the sensitivity should be turned towards the clockwise direction. The more noise there is, the further counter clockwise it should be rotated.

DECAY TIME

Adjust for most pleasing turn off time as mentioned in Par. 4 of the Description section.

BOOST

Adjust for approximately unity gain or more if noise pickup in line is excessive.
